



IMPLEMENTATION OF CAMBRIDGE SPEED MONITORING SYSTEMS

The Cambridge Mayor and Council have authorized the use of speed monitoring systems in designated school zones within the City limits.

The City of Cambridge will start operation of its speed monitoring systems with a 30-day warning period on July 15, 2011.

In accordance with State Law, beginning on August 15, 2011 \$40.00 civil citations will be issued to vehicles that exceed the posted speed limit by 12 miles per hour or more in the below stated areas.

The City of Cambridge intends to use speed monitoring systems on the following roads:

- Sandy Hill Elementary School: Glasgow Street and Jenkins Creek Road intersection within ½ mile of the school.**
- Maple Elementary School: Egypt Road and Chesapeake Drive within ½ mile of the school.**
- Cambridge-South Dorchester High School: Church Creek Road [MD16] between Maple Dam Road and Bayly Rd.**
- Open Bible Academy: Race Street [MD 341] between East Appleby Avenue and Church Creek Road [MD16].**
- Choptank Elementary School: Maces Lane and Bayly Road within ½ mile of the school.**
- Maces Lane Middle School: Washington Street [MD 343] between Center Street and St. Clair Avenue, and Maces Lane and Bayly Road within ½ mile of the school.**
- Cambridge Christian Academy: Maryland Avenue between Trenton Street and Sunburst Highway [US 50].**
